Celebrant Jane Gant will introduce herself, give a brief summary of the order of service and an overview of the early parts of Jan's life, before introducing the first speaker.

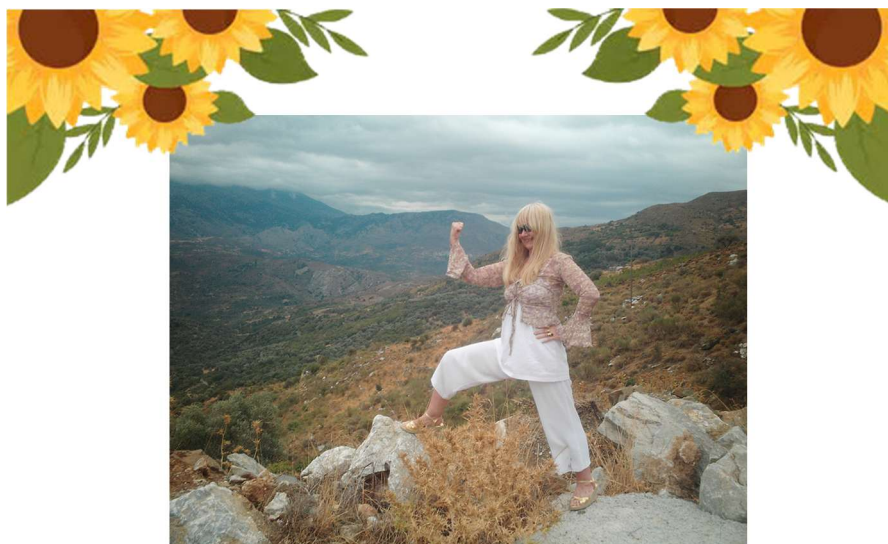
FAMILY BACKGROUND and TRIBUTE

Jan in the mountains of her beloved Crete

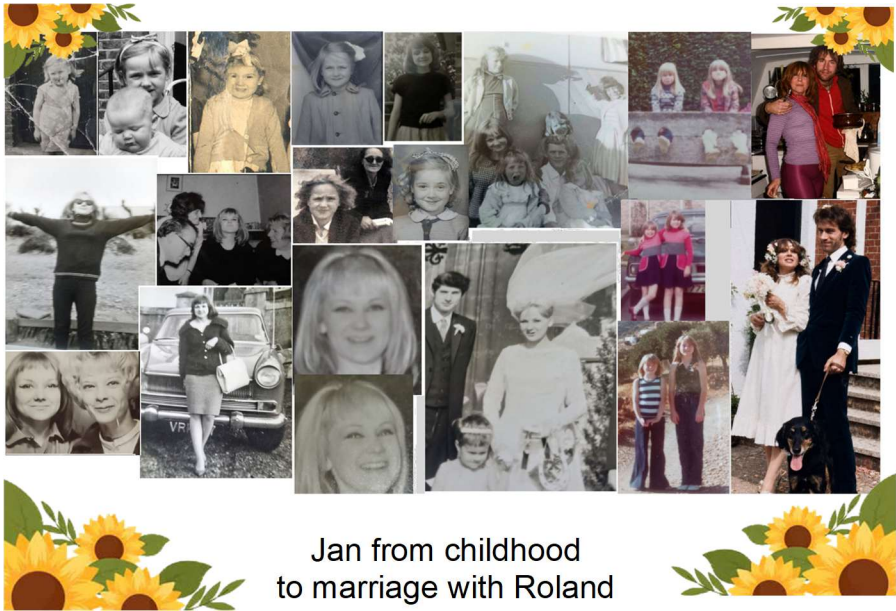
JAN's LATER LIFE
